Notice of Proposed Emergency Action

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code (GC) section 11346.1, subdivision (a)(1), the Department of Justice (Department) is providing notice of proposed emergency adoption of a regulation regarding Data Broker Registration.

Submission of Comments

GC section 11346.1, subdivision (a)(2) requires that, at least five working days prior to the submission of the proposed emergency action to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL), the adopting agency provide a notice of proposed emergency action to every person who has filed a request for notice of regulatory action with the agency. After submission of the proposed emergency regulation to the OAL, the OAL shall allow interested persons five calendar days to submit comments on the proposed emergency regulation as set forth in GC section 11349.6.

The text of the proposed emergency regulation and the “Finding of Emergency” are posted on the Department’s website at <https://oag.ca.gov/meetings/public-participation>.

The Department plans to file the emergency rulemaking package with the OAL at least five working days from the date provided at the top of this notice: December 3, 2019. If you would like to comment on the Finding of Emergency or the proposed emergency regulation, those comments must be made in writing only, must contain a notation that identifies the emergency regulation to which they relate, and must be received by both the Department and the OAL within five days of the Department’s filing with the OAL. The Department may respond to comments at its discretion. Send comments simultaneously to:
