The revenues from this penalty are deposited in the *DNA Identification Fund* established in each county's treasury. Monies in the fund are divided quarterly between the State and the County pursuant to GC 76104.6. Each county is directed to report to the Legislature and the Department of Justice, by April 1 of each year, on the total amount of fines (1) collected, (2) allocated and (3) expended for each authorized program in the preceding calendar year.
